

# Recycling Container Instructions

1. Start date will be the week of September 25<sup>th</sup>.
2. Pick up days and times will not change, unless you've been contacted because of a route change.
3. Please do not use these containers before the start date, as we will not be able to dump them with the old garbage truck.
4. Placement of the new container is critical for our operator/driver to effectively dump your container in an efficient and safe manner. Please comply with the following guidelines:
  - Place the container with the lid opening toward the street.
  - The container should be placed no closer than 4' from any obstacle, for example; utility poles, vehicles or sign posts.
  - Do not place the container behind a vehicle, as the automated arm needs access from the traveled portion of the street.
  - Where it is possible the container should be placed 2'-3' behind the curb for pick up.
  - Your emptied container should be returned to your garage or storage area by 8:00 P.M. on the day of your pick up.
  - All recyclables must be inside the container and the lid closed. This includes cardboard and it must be able to slide out when dumped.

Please note the list of recyclables included with your container. Your cooperation and help with this program promotes good stewardship of our natural resources, as well as a more cost effective Recycling Collection System.
