The rehabilitation program is for exterior housing repairs only, and may include new roofs, siding, windows, doors, gutters, and foundation repairs.

Qualified and awarded applicants may be eligible for up to \$24,999 in exterior repairs to their homes through a deferred forgivable loan over a five-year period following construction. The cost of the rehabilitation will be completely free if the homeowner remains in their home for five years following the project.
