Resolution authorizing the use of a preliminary official statement in connection with the issuance of General Obligation Corporate Purpose Bonds, Series 2021 and setting the date for the sale of the Bonds

WHEREAS, the City of Tipton (the "City"), in Cedar County, State of Iowa, pursuant to the provisions of Section 384.24A of the Code of Iowa, proposes to enter into a loan agreement (the "Loan Agreement") and to borrow money thereunder in a principal amount not to exceed \$2,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs, to that extent, of constructing street, sidewalk, sanitary sewer, storm water drainage and water system improvements and acquiring vehicles and equipment for the municipal fire and emergency response departments (collectively, the "Projects"), and pursuant to law and a notice duly published, the City Council has held a public hearing on such proposal on July 6, 2020; and

The use by the Financial Advisor of the P.O.S. relating to the Bonds in substantially the form as has been presented to and considered by the City is hereby approved, and the Financial Advisor is hereby authorized to prepare and use a final Official Statement for the Bonds substantially in the form of the P.O.S. but with such changes therein as are required to conform the same to the terms of the Bonds and the resolution, when adopted, providing for the sale and issuance of the Bonds, and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to execute a final Official Statement for the Bonds, if requested. The P.O.S. as of its date is deemed final by the City within the meaning of Rule 15(c)(2)-12 of the Securities and Exchange Commission.
- Section 3. Sealed bids for the purchase of the Bonds shall be received and canvassed on behalf of the City until 11:00 a.m. C.D.T. on May 17, 2021, at City Hall, in the City, and the City Council shall meet on the same date at \_\_\_\_\_\_ o'clock \_\_\_\_.m., at City Hall, Tipton, Iowa, for the purpose of considering such bids received and considering and passing a resolution providing for the award of the Bonds, and the Financial Advisor is hereby authorized and directed to disseminate the notice of said sale, in compliance with the Internal Revenue Service regulations governing "Issue Price" determinations, such notice to minimally contain information regarding

Establishment of Issue Price set forth in the "Terms of Offering" attached to the P.O.S. and to be in such form as the Financial Advisor may deem to be appropriate.

Section 4. Pursuant to Section 75.14 of the Code of Iowa, the City Council hereby authorizes the Financial Advisor to use electronic bidding procedures for the sale of the Bonds through Speer Auction®, and hereby finds and determines that the Speer Auction® competitive bidding system will provide reasonable security and maintain the integrity of the competitive bidding process and will facilitate the delivery of bids by interested parties under the circumstances of this bond sale.
