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## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE CITY OF TIPTON CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO ZONING REGULATIONS

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Tipton, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Chapter 165, §165.05(58) shall be repealed and replaced as set forth below:

#### Current Language to be Repealed:

58. "Principal structure" means a structure in which is conducted the principal use of the lot on which it is located.

#### Replacement language:

58. "Principal structure" means a structure, or structures when permitted, in which is conducted the principal use of the lot on which it or they are located.

SECTION 2. Chapter 165, §165.05(76) shall be repealed and replaced as set forth below:

#### Current Language to be Repealed:

76. "Yard, side" means a yard on the same lot with the building between the main building and the adjacent side of the lot, and extending from the front yard to the rear yard thereof.

#### Replacement language:

76. "Yard, side" means a yard on the same lot with the building between the main building and the adjacent side of the lot, and extending from the front yard to the rear yard thereof, not including yards falling under the definition of "Yard Side – Rear".

SECTION 3. Chapter 165, §165.05, shall be amended by the addition of a definition to be identified as §165.05 (77) as set forth below:

#### New §165.05(77):

165.05(76) "Yard, Side – Rear" means that portion of the Lot, on the same lot with a Primary Structure, where the rear of any Primary Structure abuts and/or faces the Side yard of an adjacent lot, extending across the entire length of the said Primary Structure.

Existing §165.05(77) "Zoning Lot" shall be renumbered §165.05(78)

### SECTION 4. Chapter 166, §166.05(6) shall be repealed and replaced as set forth below:

#### **Current Language to be Repealed:**

166.05 COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS. The regulations set by this Zoning Ordinance within each district shall be minimum regulations and shall apply uniformly to each class or kind of structure or land. Except as hereinafter specifically provided:

6. Every building hereafter erected or structurally altered shall be located on a lot as herein defined and in no case shall there be more than one main building on one lot.

#### Replacement language:

166.05 COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS. The regulations set by this Zoning Ordinance within each district shall be minimum regulations and shall apply uniformly to each class or kind of structure or land. Except as hereinafter specifically provided:

6. Every building hereafter erected or structurally altered shall be located on a lot as herein defined and in no case shall there be more than one <u>Principal Structure</u> on one lot, <u>unless a site plan disclosing more than one Principal Structure has been presented to and approved by the City of Tipton</u>. (Underlining shown to bring attention to updated language, will not be part of final ordinance)

SECTION 5. Chapter 166, §166.07(5) shall be repealed and replaced as set forth below:

#### Current Language to be Repealed:

166.07 R-2 TWO-FAMILY AND MULTIPLE-FAMILY RESIDENTIAL DISTRICT. The R-2 District is intended to provide areas for mixed residential developments, including single-family, two-family, and multiple-family dwellings and condominiums.

5. Height and Area Regulations. The height and area regulations set forth in this section and Sections 167.02 and 167.03 shall be observed.

A. Building height (maximum)

3 stories or 45 feet.

B. Front yard (minimum setback)

25 feet.

C. Side yard (minimum setback) Buildings less than three stories 5 feet. Buildings with three stories 10 feet. For each story above three, add 1 foot.

D. Rear yard (minimum setback)

25 feet.

### SYNOPSIS:

I've had the opportunity to visit with some (not all) business owners in the downtown district regarding the Hwy 38 project including the construction of new sidewalks.

Many problems in the alleys have been caused by Mediacom and Windstream activities. The city has been waiting to get into the alleys all year. Finally, the city had to file a municipal infraction citation.

Some of the concerns voiced by business owners:

## Question 1: Do you have concerns with the current condition of the alley behind your business? If so, what is your concern:

- · The number of potholes is horrible.
- The rain run off from the other buildings effects my building (with a bad rain).
- · Alleys are hard for pedestrians to use because of the potholes and loose gravel.
- · Alleys are a mess
- · Alleys are unsafe, potholes, and loose gravel piles
- · When it rains it becomes a problem and makes the potholes worse.
- · Potholes. People are tripping or falling. One person injured their knee.

## Do you have concerns with customers entering through your back door? If so, what is your concern?

- · No concerns, the sidewalks won't be an issue for my business next year.
- · It's impossible to use the stairs (bad condition) in the back of my building. My concerns are safety and who would be responsible if a customer falls or gets injured. How long are the sidewalks going to be torn up? That concerns me too.
- · Our customers can get in through a side door to our business. That will help.
- · Customers aren't going to be allowed to use our back door because it's a kitchen area
- · Customers aren't going to be allowed to use our back door d/t confidential information in that
- · No stairs to our back entrance.

### Do you have any concerns about security? If so, what?

· Main concern voiced from most of the businesses: lighting is poor.

## Would you object to the alley being one-way traffic.

Consensus from businesses: Makes sense for alleys to be one way. To limit problems.

Business owners have also expressed how pleased they are with pro-active conversations instead of reactive conversations. An informational meeting will be scheduled next year (most likely January 2024) for all business owners in the downtown district.
