Public Works Update, Situation with seeding North Ave.

There is still an ongoing concern with the end results of the Contractor seeding of last year's North Ave. Due to 3 separate operations installing water main, electric underground and street replacement, it was very difficult to reestablish the grass areas that were disturbed. And then adding one the driest summers on record, it was very difficult to get good results.

As a result, I have talked to Ron Challis for his analysis and recommendation for the area. His suggestion would be 1.) Work in some good black dirt in bare spots. 2.) reseed into those areas, and 3). Hydroseed on top of those areas.

This could be done this fall, however it would need to get some good moisture back in the soil prior to any seeding. Therefore, maybe a late fall dormant approach or early spring approach. Either way we need moisture and good black soil.

No decisions need to be made immediately. Just something that we might want to consider.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF THE CITY OF TIPTON CODE OF ORDINANCES RELATED TO ZONING REGULATIONS

Be It Ordained by the City Council of the City of Tipton, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Chapter 165, §165.05(58) shall be repealed and replaced as set forth below:

Current Language to be Repealed:

58. "Principal structure" means a structure in which is conducted the principal use of the lot on which it is located.

Replacement language:

58. "Principal structure" means a structure, <u>or structures when permitted</u>, in which is conducted the principal use of the lot on which it <u>or they</u> are located.

SECTION 2. Chapter 165, $\S165.05(76)$ shall be repealed and replaced as set forth below:

Current Language to be Repealed:

76. "Yard, side" means a yard on the same lot with the building between the main building and the adjacent side of the lot, and extending from the front yard to the rear yard thereof.

Replacement language:

76. "Yard, side" means a yard on the same lot with the building between the main building and the adjacent side of the lot, and extending from the front yard to the rear yard thereof, not including yards falling under the definition of "Yard Side – Rear".

SECTION 3. Chapter 165, §165.05, shall be amended by the addition of a definition to be identified as §165.05 (77) as set forth below:

New §165.05(77):

165.05(76) "Yard, Side – Rear" means that portion of the Lot, on the same lot with a Primary Structure, where the rear of any Primary Structure abuts and/or faces the Side yard of an adjacent lot, extending across the entire length of the said Primary Structure.

Existing §165.05(77) "Zoning Lot" shall be renumbered §165.05(78)

SECTION 4. Chapter 166, §166.05(6) shall be repealed and replaced as set forth below:

Current Language to be Repealed:

166.05 COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS. The regulations set by this Zoning Ordinance within each district shall be minimum regulations and shall apply uniformly to each class or kind of structure or land. Except as hereinafter specifically provided:

6. Every building hereafter erected or structurally altered shall be located on a lot as herein defined and in no case shall there be more than one main building on one lot.

Replacement language:

166.05 COMPLIANCE WITH REGULATIONS. The regulations set by this Zoning Ordinance within each district shall be minimum regulations and shall apply uniformly to each class or kind of structure or land. Except as hereinafter specifically provided:

6. Every building hereafter erected or structurally altered shall be located on a lot as herein defined and in no case shall there be more than one <u>Principal Structure</u> on one lot, <u>unless a site plan disclosing more than one Principal Structure has been presented to and approved by the City of Tipton</u>. (Underlining shown to bring attention to updated language, will not be part of final ordinance)

SECTION 5. Chapter 166, §166.07(5) shall be repealed and replaced as set forth below:

SECTION 7. WHEN EFFECIVE This ordinance shall be in effect from and after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

A RESOLUTION SCHEDULING PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED VACATION AND TRANSFER OF CITY STREET RIGHT OF WAY

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that a public hearing on the proposed Vacation and Transfer of City Street Right of Way, shall be scheduled for 5:30 p.m. on October 2, 2023 during the regular City Council meeting of the City of Tipton, held in the City Council chambers located at the Tipton Fire Station, 301 Lynn Street, Tipton, IA.at which time the City Council shall receive written and/or oral comments concerning the proposed vacation and transfer, before considering approval of a proposed Ordinance vacating and transferring said right of way, and further directs the City Manager to schedule a review of the proposed vacation and transfer by the City Planning & Zoning Commission, and to obtain a recommendation from said commission, in advance of the Public Hearing, further directing the City Clerk to cause notice of said public hearing, in the form attached hereto marked Exhibit "A", to be published at least once, not less than four (4) nor more than twenty (20) days prior to the date set for said hearing, in a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Tipton, Iowa.

Public Works Update

It was a very busy summer with our normal workload with the addition of the 38 Project and some unforeseen wind events. I'll try to give you a list of what we did across the spectrum of Public Works.

- April, removed the old shelter that the Rotary has since replaced with a nice new version, including removal of 2 old mature trees and their stumps.
- Saturday, April 22, planted 45 trees with the help of Community volunteers and a DNR Grant.
- Watered most of the trees planted this year and last year at least 5 to 6 times over the summer.
- Water Main flushing May 15 for about 2 weeks.
- Water Main break E.8th & Meridian. May 23
- Applied Calcium Chloride twice over the summer to the gravel areas on North-North Plum.
- Have put support straps in 3 trees around town to stabilize them until we remove them this winter.
- June --Started Street patching with Craftco Patcher over a month's time when we could get it worked in. Covered most of the city.
- On June 28th, Tucker started street sweeping the entire town, ahead of the 4th of July.
- Repaired 3 storm sewer pipes, requiring deep excavation.
- Monday August 1, storm cleanup all over town. 70mph winds from the north put a different leverage on older big trees.

- Mid-August, Chris and Nate painted streets at night for several days.
- Sidewalk and driveway concrete work started 8-29-23.
- Removed 2 trees in the 100 Blk of Cedar St. for the 38 project, not planned.
- Removed additional 12 trees due to the storm activity this year creating hazard trees.
- 18 total stumps removed, allowing sidewalks to be put back and new landscaping.

Keep in mind these things were accomplished by our team in Public Works while dealing with BB's absence for 6 weeks in July and August. This required Klay to cover the Water/Waste Water Dept. which left the City shop unmanned. We also team up with the Gas and Electric Departments on a regular basis when they need additional help.

We are still waiting on Windstream and Mediacom to finish their work in the alley from West 4th to West 6th, between Cedar and Lynn. We also need to install the interduct that will supply the Power to those customers. Hopefully the work will be done in time for some alley patching this fall. We would like to provide some type of smooth surface as we progress into the downtown phase of the 38 Project.

I Have met with Craig from the Kluesner Asphalt Company to see what the cost might be for a 2.5 inch overlay. I have some rough figures but need to identify which areas are strong candidates for a total overlay. More information to follow.
