Greetings,

On behalf of the Tipton Development, I would like to offer my full support of the Highway 38 Improvements project and the BUILD grant that the City of Tipton is applying for to help pay for this critical project. As the City economic development entity, we value any project which enhances the quality of life in the community because that attracts and retains employees.

The Highway 38 Improvements project will:

- increase pedestrian and motorist safety
- eliminate or reduce flooding and improve wastewater collection and treatment
- improve pedestrian and bicycle connectivity with important points-of-interest and recreational opportunities
- strengthen fire-protection capabilities
- enhance streetscapes and encourage cleanup and other development

Tipton Development is actively seeking quality, community minded businesses to join our progressive community. Building for the future, several city infrastructure projects have been completed with additional projects slated for completion over the next several years. Highway 38 is the primary north-south thoroughfare through Tipton and carries goods and travelers north connecting them to Highway 30 to travel west to Cedar Rapids, and south to connect to Interstate 80 connecting them to lowa City or Davenport.
